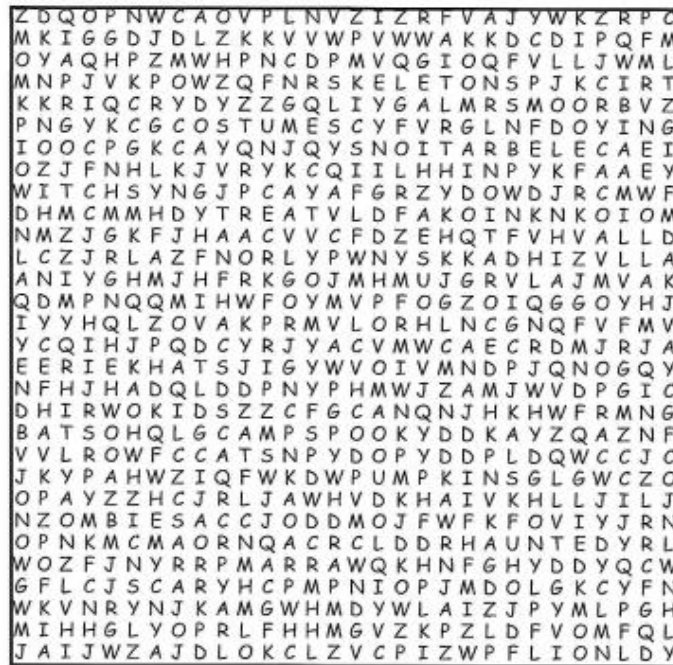

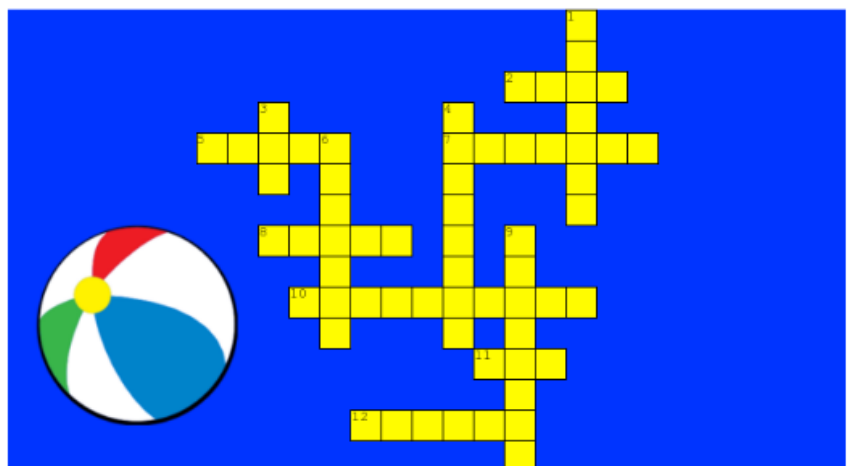

Our teacher of the month for year 8 is to Miss Russel for taking us swimming and for making P.E fun and exciting.



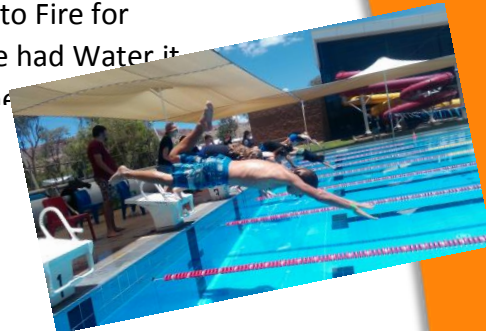
Our teacher of the month for year 9 is Mr Talbot for being amazing and making classes great.

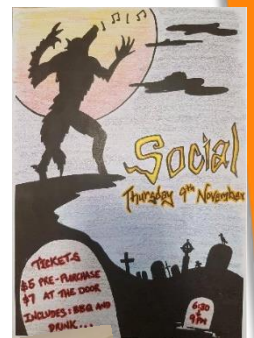


Social:

School captain:

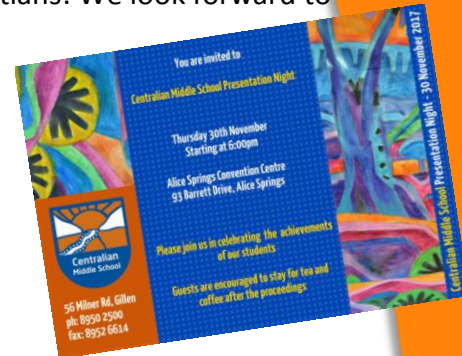
