Maths	Integers and Index Laws Test Students are learning to apply the index laws to integers. To assess their understanding of this unit they will complete a pre and post test.	Week 4
	Scientific Notation Test Students are learning to express numbers in scientific notation, with a focus on using scientific notation in real life examples, again they will be assessed in a pre and post test format.	Week 5
	Measurement Investigation Students will be investigating surface area and volume of right prisms and cylinders.	Week 10/11
Science	In class participation and bookwork Students participation in practicals and book work, this includes in class quizzes, scientific reports, modelling exercises and discussions.	Ongoing
	<b>Plate Tectonics Test</b> A comprehensive test will be undertaken at the end of the unit where students will need to be able to explain the theory of plate tectonics and analyse the history of the Australian continent.	Week 8
	<b>Research Project</b> Students will be required to apply their content knowledge and understanding to real life examples of their choice, i.e. this could be the formation of the Galapagos Island or the imminent impact of an earthquake along the San Andreas fault.	Week 10
HASS-History	Movement of people and Australian identity Students will be assessed on book work. In class activities like group work and class discussions.	Week 2, 5, an 9
	Analysis of historical documents or images - The assessments will be ongoing.	Weeks 4 - 8
	<b>Content test on movement of people</b> This is to let students demonstrate their skill of analysing documents and images, as well as knowledge of historical events by explaining historical events and analysing sources of information.	week 10
Health & PE	<b>Risk Taking / Drugs and Alcohol</b> Students in Year 9 will be exploring the concept of risk taking. They will also be furthering their knowledge about drugs and alcohol. Students will be assessed on their completed work and participation in discussions.	Ongoing Weeks 1 -5

<b>Risk Taking / Drugs and Alcohol - Quiz</b> Students will be assessed on their knowledge and understanding of effects of drugs and how it can affect their health.	Week 5
Training Methods - Training Plan Students in Year 9 will be exploring the topic of training methods. Students will be required to create personalised training plans to show their knowledge and understanding on how to improve or maintain their own or others' physical activity and fitness levels.
