Maths	Statistics & Data Students are learning to explain and investigate different techniques for collecting data including census, sampling and observation. They will be collecting class data on sleep and representing this graphically and analysing and summarising.	Week 4
	Measurement and Geometry Test Students will demonstrate their ability to identify congruence in triangles and explore the properties of quadrilaterals through an end of unit test.	Week 10
Science	Chemistry: Mystery Powders Experiment Students will apply their analytical skills and knowledge of a science lab to investigate known and unknown powders. Students will be assessed on their experiment and their scientific report which includes data tables of their findings.	Week 3
	Practical Workbook: Properties of Matter Students will complete a series of practicals investigation the properties of matter. They will draw conclusions and analyse their findings through a series of discussion questions.	Week 7

	Chemistry Overview Test Students will revise the many sub-topics covered in the Chemistry unit. They will recall their knowledge in a test assessing their overall understanding of the whole topic.	Week 10
SOSE	Economics and Business Students will design an informative poster about an Australian business' good/service that they produce. They will include information about the type of business, how the good/service is produced, the responsibilities of the producer, and rights of the consumer. Students will identify and assess how the business and product has responded to an opportunity in the market.	Week 8
Health & PE	Lifestyle Diseases: Brochure In Term 2 students in Year 8 will be exploring the topic 'Lifestyle Diseases'. The assessment task will assess students' abilities to investigate and select appropriate strategies that promote health, safety and wellbeing, within the community. The assessment task will require students to present their learning in a brochure format.	Week 8
	Athletics In Term 2 students will be practicing and performing a number of athletics events. Students will be required to complete each event, to prepare them for the school Athletics Carnival.	Ongoing
ARTS	Art Cubist portrait: Students are using a painting by Pablo Picasso as the template to create a portrait in Cubist style. Screen printing: Students are to create a stencil image for a t-shirt printing. Home Ec Students will cook a set dish in the kitchen from a recipe. Self-assessment rubrics on practical skills. PowerPoint covering all aspects of topics covered within the term. Design & Tech Students create different concept drawings for character and environment development, annotating their collaborative work as they work through the unit. The final product will be a 30sec – 1minute stop motion film. Students will learn about camera and imovie technology learning such techniques as green screens and software skills.	Week 1-10
