

## Year 7 - Assessment Schedule

Subject	Assessment Task	Due
English	<b>Bookwork</b> : In English classes this term students will complete a range of activities to help them in studying the class novel. Students will complete a reading reflection journal as they progress through the story, they will make profiles on important characters, and acquire new vocabulary to assist them in completing the two main assessment tasks detailed below. The grammar focus in year 7 this term is on sentence structure and improving students' writing cohesion, so students will improve their ability to write a variety of sentence types and join their ideas together smoothly across a text.	Ongoing Weeks 1-10
	Assessment 1: Students will be required to conduct a 2-3 minute interview with a partner where one student plays the character (the interviewee) and the other plays the interviewer. Working in pairs to create a jointly constructed script of questions and answers that show their understanding of the novel. This will then be presented as an oral presentation.	Week 5 Week 10
	Assessment 2: Using their understanding of one of the main characters in the class novel, students will write a feature article about the character. In their feature article, students will tell the life story of their chosen individual. They will explain how their life has changed, the difficulties that they have faced, and how they have developed as a person since the beginning of the novel. The feature article will be presented using captivating formatting features such as images and emboldened quotes, similar to what you might see in a magazine or on a website.	
Maths	Mid Term Exam: Fractions  Students will learn about fractions, and apply simply calculations involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. This test will examine their comprehension of this topic and abilities using these calculations.	Week 5
	End of Term Exam: Decimals, Percentages and Ratios Students will learn about decimals, percentages and ratios, and apply these to everyday life. This exam will focus on conversion between fractions, decimals, percentages and ratios through real life example questions.	Week 10
	Alternating Fortnightly Quiz and Book Check Students are expected to keep ongoing notes in their workbooks throughout the term.	Weekly
Science	Habitats in Alice Springs Desert Park - Students will learn about ecosystem, classification and biodiversity. They will attend an excursion to the Alice Springs Desert Park and are expected to collect data, classify animals and plants, create a food web and describe the impact of disrupting an ecosystem.	Week 10

	Class discussions and written book work to assess students' depth of understanding of the effect of human and environmental changes on interactions between organisms; and classify diverse organisms based on observable differences.	Ongoing
SOSE	<b>Assessment 1</b> : Students are to conduct a mock interview with two people from different social classes in Egyptian Society. Students will generate questions and answers using the historical inquiry and exploring different perspectives of Egyptian social groups. This is an oral presentation.	Week 6-7
	<b>Assessment 2 Part 1:</b> Students will develop a "How to Guide" in how to mummify a family member. Exploring the process of death and funeral customs and how they have changed overtime.	Week 9
	<b>Assessment 2 Part 2:</b> Students will create a model of a tomb or Egyptian Mummy.	Week 10
	<b>Bookwork:</b> Throughout the term, students will engage with ongoing activities to develop understanding of the topics discussed and learn the skills required for historical investigation.	Ongoing
Health & PE	<b>Tobacco &amp; Alcohol: Workbook</b> - During Term 3 students will be exploring the topic of tobacco and alcohol and will be investigating the effects they have on health and wellbeing. Students will be required to provide evidence of their learning in their workbook.	Ongoing
	<b>Tobacco &amp; Alcohol: Presentation:</b> Students will be required to present a PowerPoint presentation to the class about the effects of tobacco or smoking.	Week 8
