English	Timed Writing Essay Students will undertake a series of timed narrative and persuasive writing activities.	Week 1 - 4

Maths	Mid Term Exam: Statistics - Data and Graphs Students will learn about data and the centre of measures of spread, and different types of graphs and tables. They will be assessed with an exam.	Week 4
	Exam: Cartesian Plane & Algebra Students are learning about the Cartesian plane, and how shapes are reflected and transformed across it. Additionally, the basics of algebra, including terminology, formulas, substitution and how algebra is used in everyday life will be taught. This exam will assess their knowledge on these topics. 	Maths Online and Booklets Each student completes a booklet each week. They also have the opportunity to master fluency on topics on MathsOnline.	Ongoing
Science	Habitats in Alice Springs Desert Park - Report - Students will learn about the ecosystem, classification and biodiversity. They will attend an excursion to the Alice Springs Desert Park and are expected to collect data, classify animals and plants, create a food web and describe the impact of disrupting an ecosystem. Students will produce a report to describe their findings.	Week 10
	Class discussions and written book work to assess students' depth of understanding of the effect of human and environmental changes on interactions between organisms, and classify diverse organisms based on observable differences.	Ongoing
HASS	Civics and Citizenship Students will be required to create a campaign to run for Prime Minister. They will create a campaign poster and manifesto that includes Australian values and explains how they embody those values.	Week 5
	Economics and Business Students will design their own product and produce a pitch that persuades potential buyers to purchase the product.	Week 10
Health and PE	Tobacco & Alcohol - Workbook Students will explore the topic of tobacco and alcohol and investigate the effects they have on health and wellbeing.	Ongoing
	Tobacco & Alcohol - Presentation Students will present a PowerPoint presentation to the class about the effects of tobacco or smoking.	Week 8
	Athletics Students will be practice and perform a number of athletics events. Students will be required to complete each event to prepare them for the school athletics carnival.	Ongoing
